**Trail route to include Lavender Fields,
Northfield Cottages and Tile Barn Close**

This year's theme is **the 1970's**

You are invited to enter a scarecrow based loosely on 1970's

Guidelines

- The scarecrow needs to be robust enough to withstand a week outside in all weathers
- Please have your scarecrow in position by sunset on Saturday 16th June, any format, size and filling of scarecrow is acceptable.
- You don't have to live along the route to take part, we can find a volunteer garden for you.
- All scarecrows are to be displayed in front gardens (or on the front of your house, or front hedge) but please remember not to obstruct the footpath.
- Please consider hanging bunting around your garden, fences, houses etc to make a festive atmosphere for Fete Week.

The Trail Route is from Lavender Line Station, cross the road to Lavender Fields, then back over the road to go past Isfield Farm Shop, crossing the road by the village sign, over the playing field (look for a scarecrow here), towards the swings, down the twitten to Northfield Cottages and then cross the road into Tile Barn Close.

Apologies if your house is not on this route, but the routes have been chosen with safety in mind, incorporating footpaths with minimal need to walk on the roadside. It also avoids disruption of vehicles slowing down at inappropriate points along the road causing a hazard.

Please complete the Registration Form and return it by **Weds 13th June** to allow time for the trail/voting sheet to be finalised and printed which will be available from Sues Crawford and the Laughing Fish during the week before the Fete and from the Scarecrow Stall on Fete Day.

Come and see the Scarecrow Stall at the Fete on Sun 24th June and vote for your favourite! A photo of each entry will be displayed, with a prize for the scarecrow with the most votes.
